Innervation of the Dorsum of the Foot

- 1. Superficial peroneal nerve
- 2. Intermedial dorsal cutaneous nerve
- 3. Lateral dorsal common digital branch
 - a. innervates skin on the adjacent sides of the 4th/5th toes
- 4. Medial dorsal common digital branch
 - a. innervates skin on the adjacent sides of the 3rd and 4th toes
- 5. Medial dorsal cutaneous nerve
- 6. <u>Dorsal common digital branch of the medial</u> <u>dorsal cutaneous nerve</u>
 - a. innervates skin on the adjacent sides of the 2nd and 3rd toes
- 7. <u>Dorsal proper digital branch of the medial</u> <u>dorsal cutaneous nerve</u>
 - a. innervates skin on the dorsomedial aspect of the hallux
- 8. <u>Lateral dorsal cutaneous nerve</u> (continuation of the sural nerve)
- 9. <u>Saphenous nerve</u>
 - a. innervates skin on the medial side of the foot up to the 1st MPJ
