Contamination	-presence of non-replicating bacteria on wounds -essentially all wounds are considered contaminated -no antibiotics are necessary
Colonization	-bacteria adhere to base of wound and replicate -doesNOT impair healing -does NOT require antibiotics
Critical colonization	-affects skin proliferation and tissue repair (wound demonstrates increased exudate, red/friable granulation tissue, + malodor) -no systemic response -topical antibiotics are appropriate

-local or systemic response leading to infection
